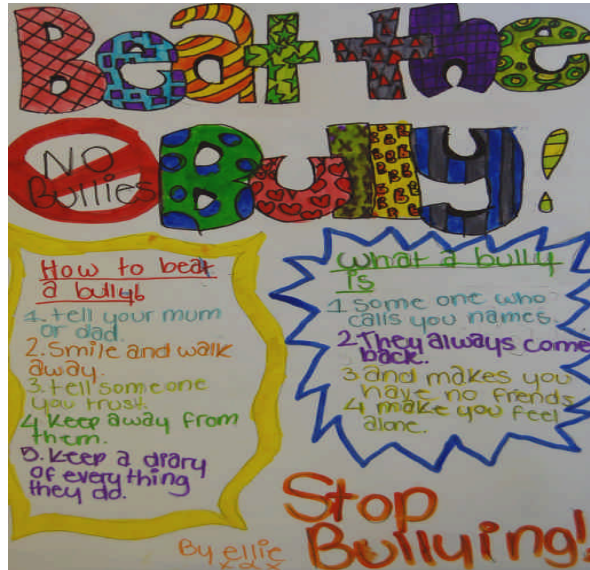
LEA ENDOWED PRIMARY SCHOOL SEEK TO DISCOURAGE BULLYING

CLIMATE CHANGE FUNDING IS AVAILABLE THROUGH LANCASHIRE LOCALS

What is the Lancashire Locals Climate Change Fund?

The Lancashire Locals Climate Change Fund is a new fund to support community projects on climate change. These projects can either be aimed at 'reducing greenhouse gas emissions', or helping communities to 'cope with the impacts of climate change'. Grants will normally be in the range of £500 - £15,000. The fund is shared across all 12 Lancashire Locals.

Who can apply?

The fund is open to voluntary organisations, community groups and parish/town councils. The fund is **not** open to public sector organisations or schools.

What projects are eligible for funding?

To be considered, the project must demonstrate that it reduces greenhouse gas emissions or helps communities to cope with the impacts of climate change.

How can you apply ?

Applications for this year should be submitted by 31st October 2008 to Lancashire Locals
