Minutes : The minutes of the meeting on 10th June were agreed as a true record.

Trustee : Rose Jones was co-opted as a Trustee for a period of five years.

Matters Arising : The proposed grant application for funding from The Young Peoples Services was discussed. The requirement that young people must apply for this award was noted and action deferred to a later date.

Preston Neighbourhood Management : Rosie Green from PCC explained her role as Community Support Officer and detailed how she could help our group in organising community events, fund raising and liaising with departments at PCC and other official bodies we may have to deal with as our organisation develops

Jubilee Park Development : The meeting was informed that our application for funding to Lea and Cottam Parish Council had been successful and we had been awarded £1k towards the football pitch. Other bids still pending included £2k from William Sutton Homes and an unspecified amount from the police organisation, Lanpac.

Discussion took place on the possibility of introducing traffic calming measures and providing parking spaces on Sheffield Drive. RG will pursue with LCC.

Future Activities : A request was made for the young people to be kept updated on progress in providing the football pitch. BW offered to publish a newsletter when the result of the WSH bid was known. BW also explained that a page could be created for JAG on the Parish web site.

RG explained how Facebook and Twitter are effective means of communication enjoyed by young people and would help to set this up for our group.

The meeting was informed that mobile changing rooms may become available to purchase. GP will make further inquiries.

Thought was given to arranging activities for local senior citizens. EH agreed to speak with members of our senior community to gauge demand and explore areas of interest

AOB : RG asked the meeting to consider ideas for community events. The completion of the football pitch was suggested as an appropriate time to hold such an event..
