Minutes of Last Meeting : The minutes of the meeting on 24th August were agreed.

Matters Arising : An account of our recent trip to Old Trafford was given ; A group of 22 juniors and 6 adults enjoyed a visit to the stadium on 28/08/09. Whilst there we were given a conducted tour of the ground and spent time looking at the many exhibits on show in the museum. The total cost of the trip was £457.38. This sum being raised with a £350 grant from WSH and contributions from the visiting group.

County Councillor Bill Winlow : The LCC for Preston West, Cllr Bill Winlow, was introduced and invited to address the Meeting. He welcomed the opportunity and supported our efforts to improve recreational and social activity in the area. He also made us aware of the LCC Local Members Grants Scheme . This is a small funding pot available to community groups through an application to their County Councillor. Cllr Winlow was thanked for this suggestion and the meeting agreed the secretary should apply for this grant to fund the proposed senior citizen Trip to Skipton Market.

Jubilee Park Development : Nothing to report. Waiting PCC to start work on the football pitch, for which, funding is now in place. Secretary to urge with PCC Parks and Horticultural Dept.

Future Activities : The meeting was informed that the Skipton Christmas market trip would take place on Sunday 6/12/09 with the coach costing £265.00. Interest had been encouraging and bookings taken. Suggestions for future activities included The Dockland Railway and Liverpool FC. A request was made to obtain complimentary tickets for this years Christmas pantomime at the Guildhall

AOB : A general discussion took place regarding activities and facilities on Jubilee Park. Thought was given to the desirability of moving the childrens play area closer to Sheffield Drive ; Cllr Winlow agreed to discuss the provision of improved parking on Sheffield drive with highways at LCC ; Efforts to obtain containers for changing rooms continue ; There was a need to establish the type of goalposts PCC are to provide on the football pitch ; are they to be fixed or require storing when not in use.?
